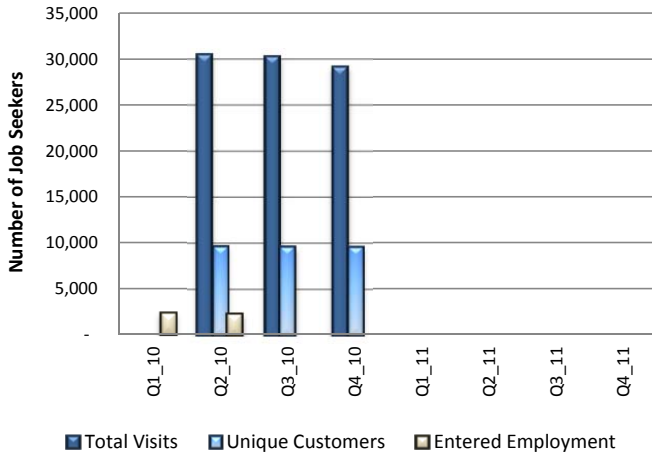
BUSINESS CUSTOMERS 4th Quarter 2010



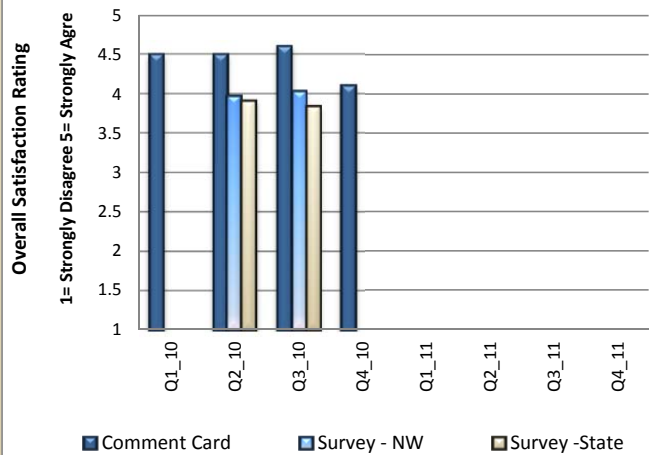
BUSINESS SATISFACTION 4th Quarter 2010



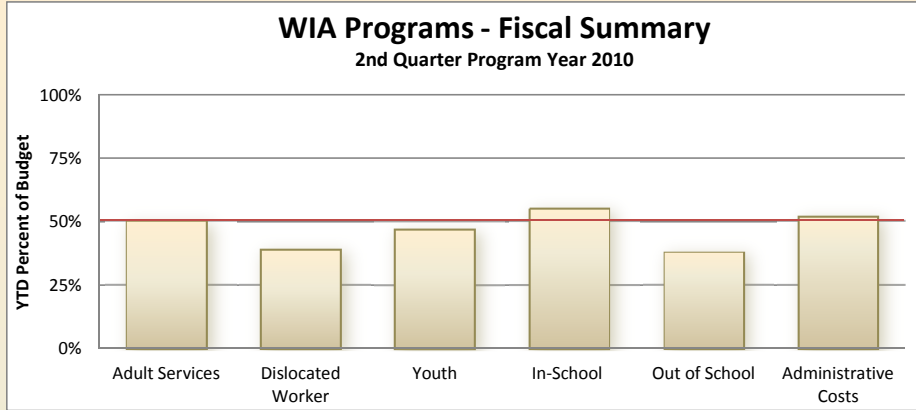

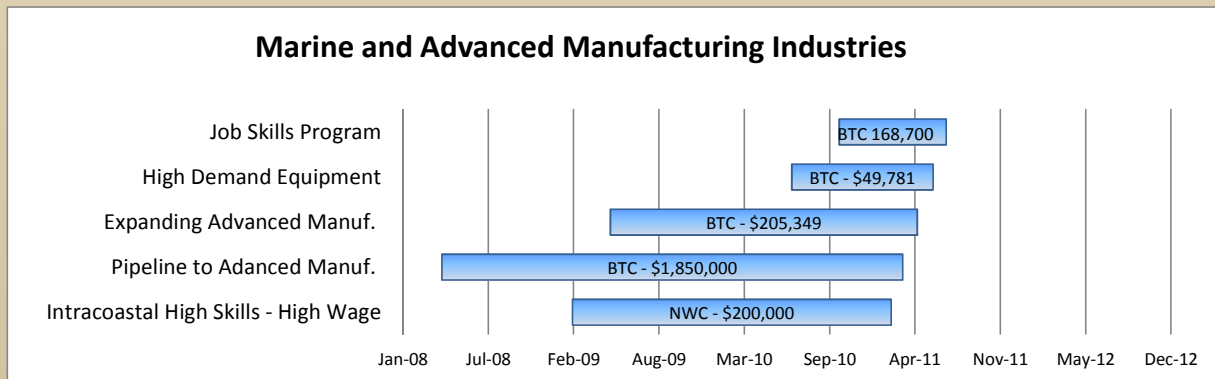
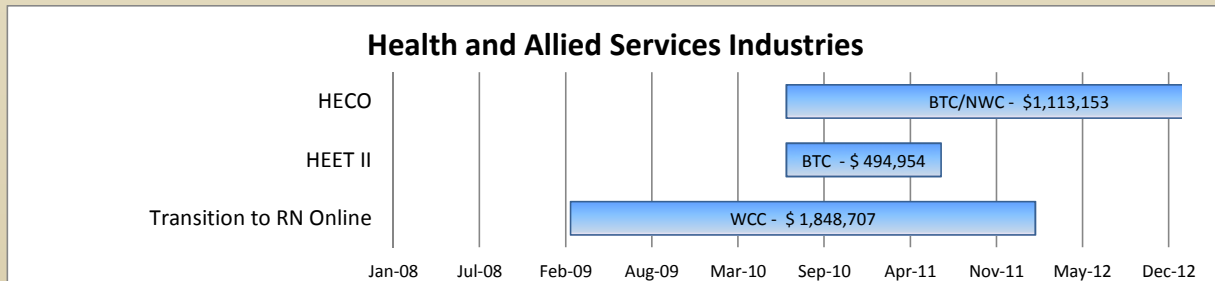
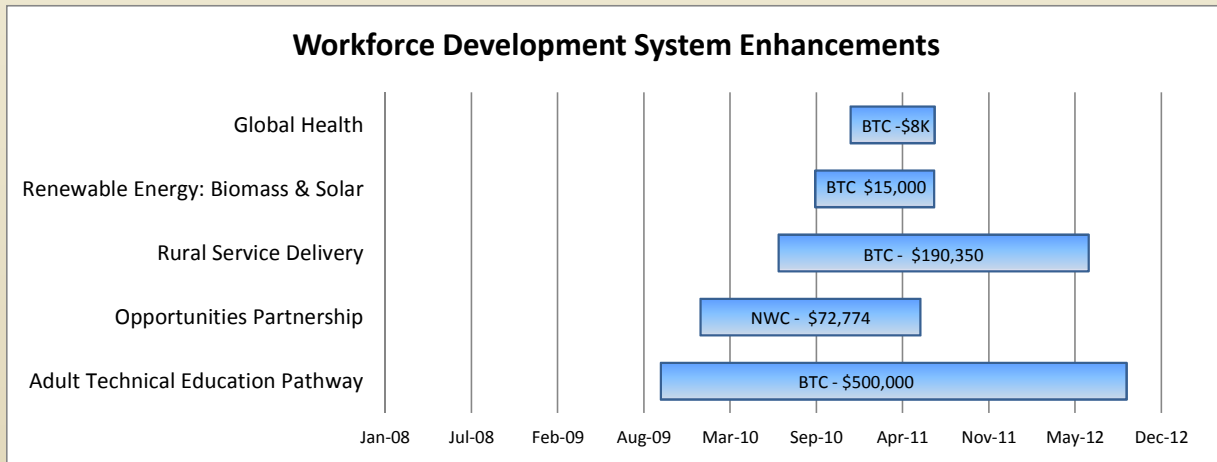


Program budget expenditures are on track 50% of the way through the program year.

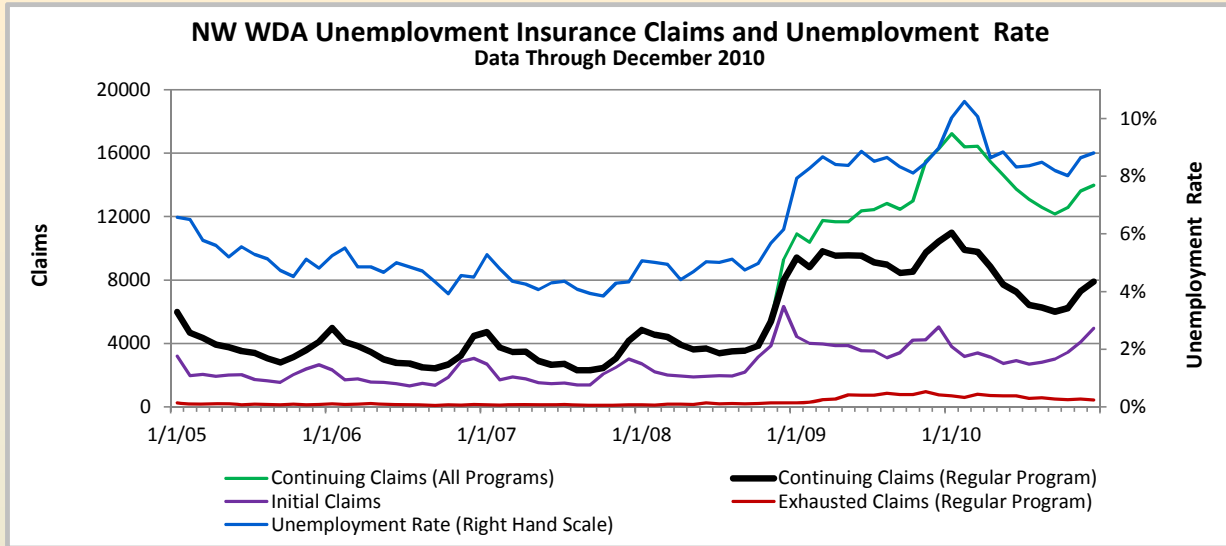
Dislocated Worker spending is trailing due to ARRA, On Job Training NEG, and SB-5809 training reimbursements. We are currently able to recruit additional youth.

Below is an outline of competitive grants and projects underway in the system. Timeline bars are color coded as follows:

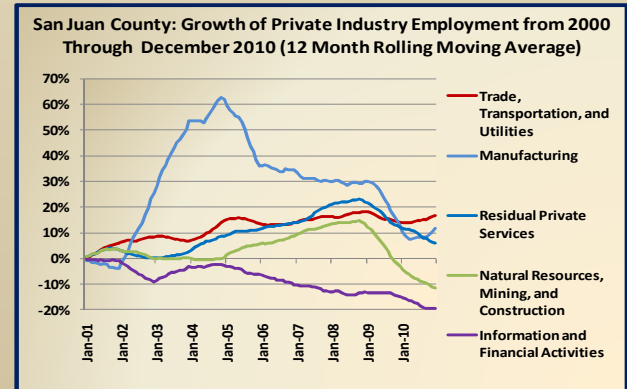
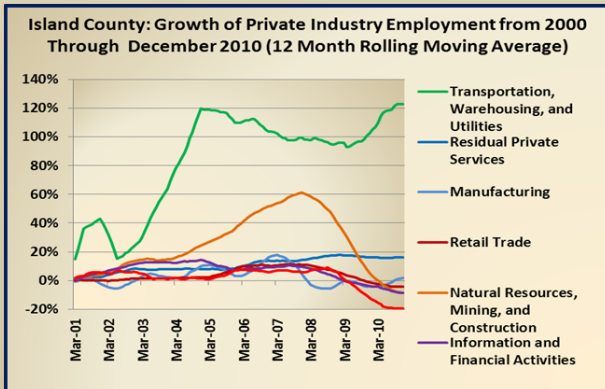
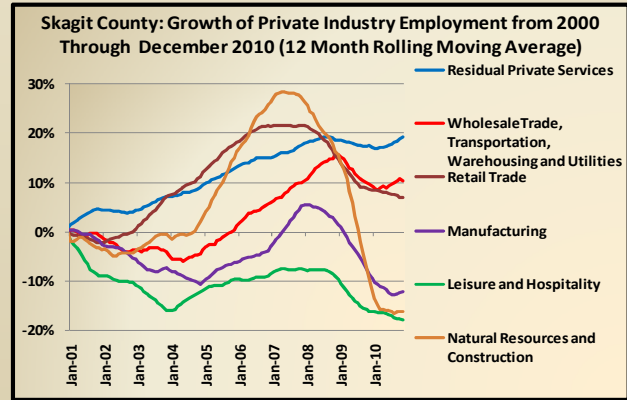
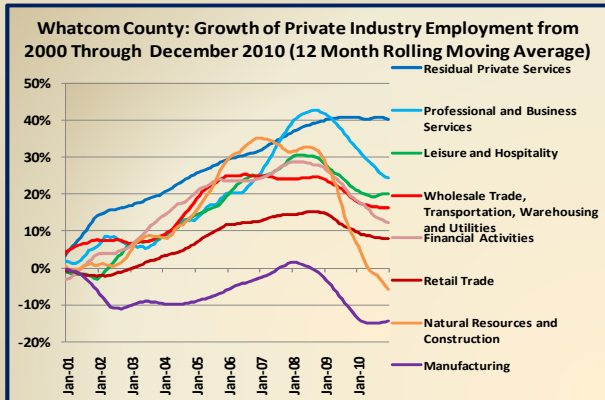

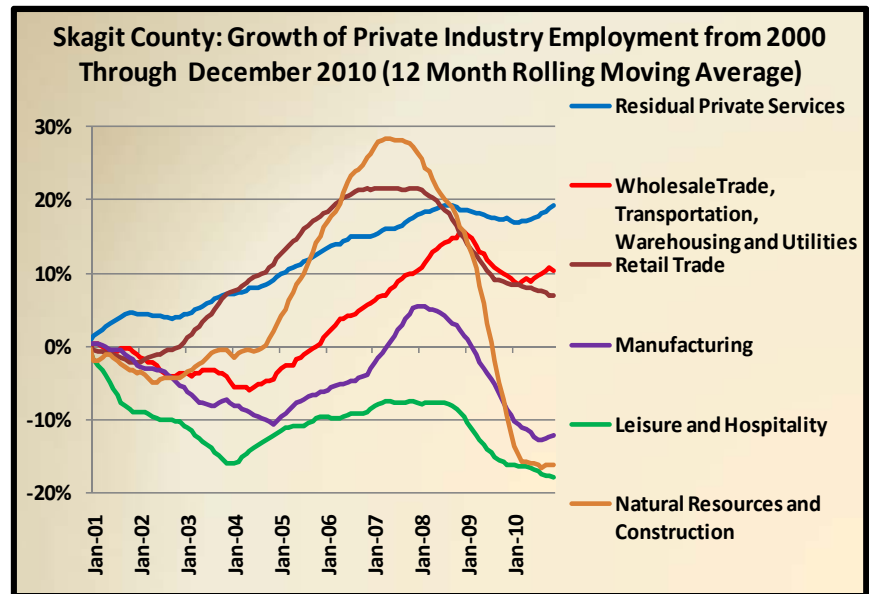
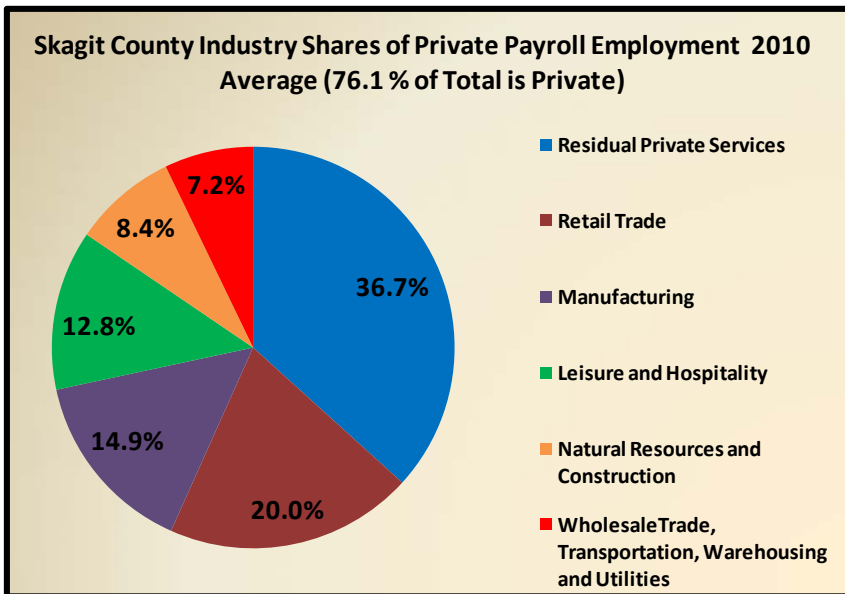
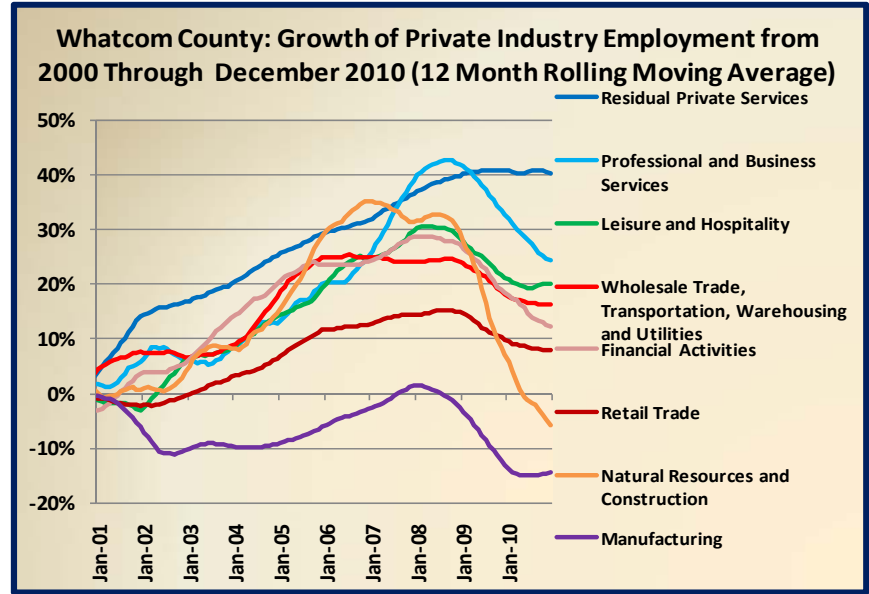
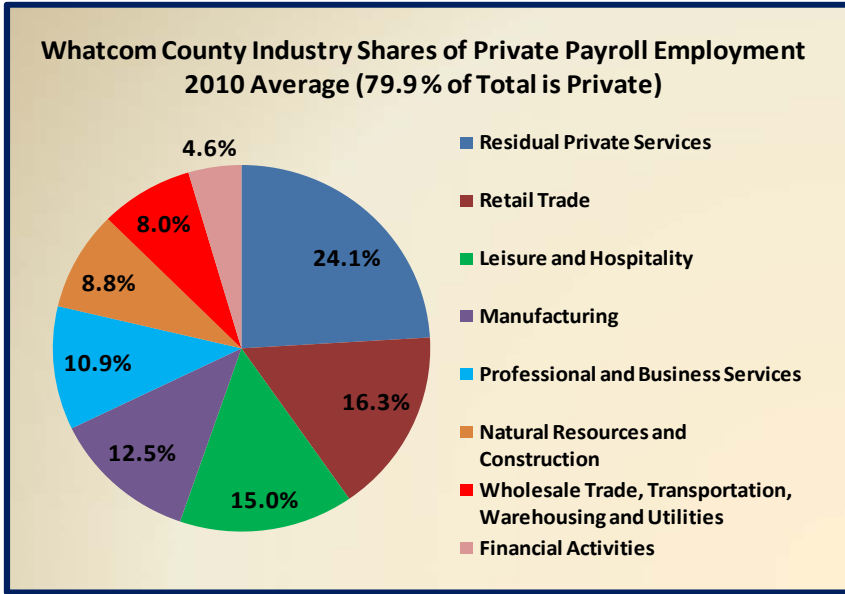
Northwest Workforce System Performance Regional Unemployment



- Data is not seasonally adjusted (December 2010 values noted).
- Claims data is on the left hand scale and the unemployment rate (8.8%) on the right hand scale.
- Continuing claims (heavy black line) are for the regular UI program only (7,909).
- Adding the EUC and EB continuing claims (6,075) to the regular continuing claims results in the green line (13,984 total). Note that this results in a 254 person over count as some claimants may be regular and EUC during their month of transition from one program to another.
- As the UEC and EB programs are eventually discontinued, exhausted claims may rise significantly unless significant job growth has returned, but this will not affect the unemployment rate directly, as those exhaustees are already unemployed.
